When writing your report, resist the temptation to play up the test you favor and downplay the one with divergent results, he advises. For example, someone might score high on a performance-based measure of interpersonal dependence, like the Rorschach test, but low on a self-report measure of interpersonal dependence, says Bornstein, one of the editors of "Multimethod Clinical Assessment" (Guilford Press, 2014).
